**DEGREE AND BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMS**

**PART ONE**  
**Purpose, Scope, Basis, Definitions**

**Purpose**

**ARTICLE 1-** (1) The purpose of this directive is to regulate the procedures and principles related to the admission of students from abroad to associate and undergraduate programs at Fenerbahçe University.

**Scope**

**ARTICLE 2-** (1) This directive covers the procedures and principles related to the admission of students from abroad to associate degree and undergraduate programs at Fenerbahçe University.

**Basis**

**ARTICLE 3-** (1) This directive has been prepared on the basis of Articles 14/b/1 and 45/f of the Higher Education Law published in the Official Gazette dated 06/11/1981 and numbered 17506 and the Principles Regarding the Admission of Students from Abroad announced by the Council of Higher Education.

**Definitions**

**ARTICLE 4-** (1) What is mentioned in this directive refers to,

- a) Unit: The faculties and vocational schools within Fenerbahçe University,
- b) Unit Board: The boards of faculties and vocational schools affiliated to Fenerbahçe University,
- c) Unit Manager: Deans in faculties and directors in vocational schools within Fenerbahçe University,
- d) Unit Administrative Board: Administrative boards of faculties and vocational schools affiliated to Fenerbahçe University,
- e) Head of Department/Program: Heads of departments/programs of faculties and vocational schools within Fenerbahçe University,
- f) English Preparatory Program: Fenerbahçe University English Preparatory Program,
- g) English Proficiency Exam: Fenerbahçe University English Proficiency Exam,
- h) Board of Trustees: Fenerbahçe University Board of Trustees,
- i) Student Affairs Fenerbahçe University Student Affairs Directorate,
- j) ÖSYS: Student Selection and Placement System,
- k) Rector: Rector of Fenerbahçe University,
- l) Senate: Fenerbahçe University Senate,
- m) T.C.: The Republic of Türkiye,
- n) TÖMER: Turkish Language Teaching Application and Research Center,

- o) International Relations Directorate: Director of International Relations at Fenerbahçe University,
- p) University: Fenerbahçe University (FBU),
- q) University Board of Directors: Fenerbahçe University Board of Directors,
- r) YÖK: Council of Higher Education.

## **PART TWO**

### **Principles Related to the Quota and Registration Process**

#### **Quota**

**ARTICLE 5-** (1) When accepting students from abroad, quotas are allocated to associate degree and undergraduate level programs of the University.

(2) Quotas are determined by the proposal of the departments, the decision of the Senate and the approval of the Board of Trustees and notified to the Council of Higher Education. It is finalized with the approval of the Higher Education Council.

(3) Quotas of programs, language of instruction, evaluation, registration process, preparatory class, if any, and other relevant information are announced on the University's website, and important dates are also shown in the academic calendar.

(4) Quotas belonging to programs whose student quotas from abroad are not filled can be transferred to other programs in accordance with the procedures determined by the Higher Education Council.

#### **Application**

**ARTICLE 6-** (1) Candidates who have the qualifications specified in the list in Annex-1 may apply for international student status, provided that they are registered in the last year of high school or equivalent school or are high school graduates.

(2) Applications of candidates who meet the following conditions are evaluated:

- a) Foreign national candidates,
- b) Candidates who have been granted permission to renounce their Turkish citizenship by the Ministry of Interior even though they are Turkish citizens by birth, and those who have a Document on the Exercise of Recognized Rights granted in accordance with the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 from their minor children who are registered in their Turkish citizenship renunciation document,
- c) Those who obtained Turkish citizenship while being a foreign citizen or dual-national candidates who are in this case,
- d) Candidates who are students of Republic of Turkey (TR) nationality attending secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013 and completed the last three years of high school or equivalent education in a foreign country other than the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) (including those who completed their high school education in Turkish schools opened by the Ministry of National Education (MoNE) in foreign countries other than TRNC),
- e) Candidates who started secondary education abroad after 01/02/2013 and completed all of their high school or equivalent education in a foreign country other than the

TRNC (including those who completed it in Turkish schools opened by the Ministry of National Education in foreign countries other than the TRNC),

- f) TRNC nationals who reside in the TRNC and have completed high school or equivalent education in this country and have a “GCE AL” certificate, as well as those who have a “GCE AL” certificate by studying at high school or equivalent schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010, or candidates who will have this certificate until the last day of the final registration period designated for foreign nationals in the academic calendar.

(3) Candidates who have the following qualifications cannot apply for the foreign student quota:

- a) T.C. candidates who are citizens and have completed all of their high school or equivalent education in Turkey or the TRNC,
- b) Candidates who are TRNC citizens and have completed all of their high school or equivalent education in the TRNC who do not have the “GCE AL” certificate, or who will not be able to have this certificate until the last day of the final registration period designated for foreign nationals in the academic calendar,
- c) Except for those meeting the conditions in clauses (b), (c), and (d) of this article (2), dual citizenship applicants whose first nationality at birth is the Republic of Turkey are also included,
- d) Dual nationality candidates, one of whose nationality is TRNC, except for those who have completed their high school or equivalent education in TRNC and have “GCE AL” certificate and those who have “GCE AL” certificate by studying in high schools or equivalent schools in other countries between 2005-2010 or those who will have this certificate until the last day of the final registration period determined for foreign nationals in the academic calendar,
- e) Turkish citizens who have completed their education in schools within the embassies in Turkey, as well as those in foreign schools in Turkey or equivalent foreign schools, and dual citizens whose first nationality at birth is the Republic of Turkey, except within the framework of clause (b) of this article (2),
- f) Because of a crime he committed, T.C. candidates who have been stripped of their citizenship,
- g) Candidates who have been banned from entering Turkey.

### **Types of Exams Required for Application, Base Scores and Diplomas**

**ARTICLE 7-** (1) Candidates who have the types of exams or diplomas and scores at the national or international level specified in Annex-1 may apply. With the decision of the Senate, new exams and conditions may be added, admission principles may be updated.

(2) The exams that have the status of high school graduation exams (Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.) there is no limitation on the validity periods. The exams that have the status of university entrance exam (SAT, etc.) their validity period is two years.

(3) Applicants from countries not included in Annex-1 must have at least a 50% success rate in their high school graduation scores.

## **Application Process and Requested Documents**

**ARTICLE 8-** (1) Applications are made electronically in accordance with the academic calendar within the framework of the procedures and principles announced on the University's website. According to the characteristics of the applied program, the documents requested by the University are announced on the web page.

(2) Applications of candidates who cannot meet the application conditions and who cannot submit the necessary information and documents for the application in full within the time limit will not be processed. After the application process is completed, changes and/or additions cannot be made to the application information and documents.

(3) Candidates may be asked to verify the information and documents submitted during the application, and the University may investigate the accuracy of these information and documents. The admission decision of the candidate who is found to have any irregularities in his/her information and documents is canceled even if he/she has been accepted to the program, and his/her registration is deemed invalid even if he/she has been registered to the University.

(4) The documents required for the application are as follows:

- a) English or Turkish notarized translation of the diploma or temporary graduation certificate obtained from high school or equivalent (if it is prepared in a language other than Turkish or English).
- b) Transcript or printout of the student report cards received during high school education (if prepared in a language other than Turkish or English, notarized translation in Turkish or English).
- c) A photocopy of the page showing the picture and identity information in the passport (if it is prepared in a language other than Turkish or English, a notarized translation in Turkish or English).
- d) If it is stipulated in the announcement, a photocopy of the exam result documents for the exams shown in Annex-1 (notarized translations in Turkish or English).
- e) Other documents requested in the announcement text.

(5) If the necessary information is stated in the documents requested for the application in English, it is not required that they be translated into Turkish.

## **Evaluation**

**ARTICLE 9-** (1) Candidates who meet the application requirements are evaluated by the International Relations Directorate. The candidate is informed about the evaluation result electronically, and a "conditional acceptance letter" is sent to the candidates whose results are positive.

(2) Having fulfilled the application conditions does not mean that the student has been accepted definitively. The International Relations Directorate makes the evaluation by taking into account the grade point average required for application, the minimum scores to be obtained from exams or exams, and the quotas determined by the University, as specified in Annex-1. Candidates may be subjected to an interview by the relevant unit according to the characteristics of the program, if deemed necessary, as a result of the preliminary evaluation to be made on the basis of application information and documents. Admission of students to

departments that accept students with a special aptitude exam is made according to the procedures and principles determined by the relevant program for the special aptitude exam.

(3) If the number of students applying is at or less than the quota limit determined by the University, all candidates who meet the application requirements and are deemed suitable by the International Relations Directorate are accepted to the University. If the number of applications exceeds the quota, the International Student Admission Commission evaluates the applicants by taking into account the assessment and evaluation criteria according to the graduation grade point average and the characteristics of the program, if any. Applicants are ranked from the highest evaluation score to the lowest. When choosing between candidates with equal assessment score, priority is given to those who are younger than the applicants.

(4) The “unconditional registration acceptance letter” approved by the International Relations Directorate is sent to the students who have been accepted and paid in advance electronically. Candidates must obtain a “Study Visa” by going to the Turkish Embassy in their home country with this letter. The candidates themselves are responsible for carrying out the procedures related to the study visa and all the costs that may arise related to these procedures.

## **Registration**

**ARTICLE 10-** (1) Candidates who have earned the right to register apply for registration in person or through their legal representatives.

(2) The documents required for registration are as follows:

- a) The original diploma and/or temporary graduation certificate or a certified copy by a notary/consulate/school issuing the diploma or the Turkish Republic representation in that country.
- b) A copy of the transcript approved by a notary/consulate or the relevant school.
- c) The original of the exam result documents or documents of the national or international exams entered by the candidate, if any, and/or copies approved by the notary/ consulate or the relevant institution.
- ç) A visa that candidates residing abroad will receive from the Turkish representative office in their country of residence, or a photocopy of the original “residence permit” that candidates residing in Turkey will receive from the Provincial Directorate of Migration Management for submission. Visa requirements are not required only for the candidates mentioned below:
  - i. Foreign students who want to complete their secondary education in Turkey and do associate and undergraduate studies without interruption, as well as children of foreigners who have a work and residence permit in Turkey,
  - ii. Those who acquired Turkish citizenship by birth and later acquired the citizenship of a foreign state by obtaining permission to renounce Turkish citizenship with the decision of the Council of Ministers (including those who have a document on the exercise of the rights recognized by Law No. 5901),
  - iii. Dual citizens who were originally foreign nationals at birth and later acquired Turkish citizenship, as well as Turkish citizens who completed all of their high school or equivalent education in a foreign country other than the TRNC,
- e) A bank statement confirming that the tuition fee has been deposited.

f) A photocopy of the page of the passport showing the picture and identity information (if it is prepared in a language other than Turkish or English, a notarized translation in Turkish or English).

g) 3 passport-sized photos.

ğ) Other documents specified in the text of the announcement.

h) In addition, the following documents are requested from the students who will apply for the residence permit;

i. Health insurance,

ii. 4 passport-size photos,

iii. A written document that shows the address information.

(3) Documents prepared in a language other than Turkish or English must be accompanied by Turkish or English translations certified by a notary public or a representative office of the Republic of Turkey. However, if the documents in question contain the necessary information in English, the translation requirement is not required.

(4) Candidates who have not made their final registration between the specified dates cannot claim any rights. They cannot complete the registration process by sending their documents by mail.

(5) If it is not possible to submit the original documents during the registration procedures and / or if there is a document that the student can obtain at a later date, the transaction is made, and the student certificate is issued on the condition that a commitment is signed that the original document will be delivered. The original documents must be submitted by the specified deadline. Otherwise, the admission and/or registration procedures of the candidates will be canceled.

(6) The registration of those who do not pay the tuition fee within the announced period and/or on the dates specified in the submitted payment plan shall be canceled.

(7) If it is understood at any stage that any of the documents required for final registration is a fake or falsified document, the registration of the relevant student is canceled as of the registration date and legal proceedings are initiated by the University against the student. If this student has left the University, all documents, including the diploma given to him, will be canceled. The tuition fees paid by these students will not be refunded.

(8) In the event of a visa refusal, the tuition fee is non-refundable. In case of an exceptional situation, the refund conditions specified in the conditional acceptance letter apply.

(9) Students are obliged to obtain a residence permit for study purposes within one month at the latest from the date of entry into Turkey after completing their enrollment at the university, and students with residence permits obtained from outside Istanbul are obliged to move their files to Istanbul. Students themselves are responsible for covering all costs that may arise in relation to these procedures and for fulfilling the procedures in accordance with the law.

(10) The documents requested by the University regarding visa and residence permits are based on the current circulars of the authorized public institutions regarding foreign students.

### **Language Proficiency**

**ARTICLE 11-** (1) Foreign students admitted to programs whose language of instruction is Turkish must have at least “TÖMER B2” or equivalent score in order to start their studies. Fenerbahce University TÖMER's decision is essential for students to be able to start their studies. Those who do not have at least B2 language level are initiated to the Turkish preparatory class opened within the University. Students in this situation are charged a preparatory class tuition fee. The time spent in the preparatory class is not counted as the learning period.

(2) A student who has earned the right to enroll in the Turkish-taught programs of the university may attend the English foreign language preparatory class for a period of one year if he/she wishes. Students in this situation are charged a preparatory class tuition fee. The one-year period spent in the preparatory class is not counted as the study period. Upon request, students who attend the foreign language preparatory class continue to the program they have earned the right to enroll in at the end of one year.

(3) In order for a student to start a program taught in a foreign language or with a mandatory foreign language preparatory class, he must pass the proficiency exam conducted by the Department of Foreign Languages, or obtain a score determined by the Senate from one of the foreign language exams accepted by the Council of Higher Education/OSYM /Senate, provided that it is in the relevant language, or succeed by attending a foreign language preparatory class. Which level students will study at is determined by the level determination exam conducted by the Department of Foreign Languages.

(4) Students who do not succeed in the foreign language proficiency exam are enrolled in the foreign language preparatory class. A student who succeeds in the proficiency exam to be held at the end of the first semester in the preparatory class or receives a score deemed sufficient by the Senate in one of the foreign language exams specified in the third paragraph is eligible to study in the program in which he was placed in the second semester.

### **Tuition Fee**

**ARTICLE 12-** (1) Tuition fees are subject to tuition fees at Fenerbahce University. The tuition fee is determined and announced by the Board of Trustees every year.

## **THE THIRD PART Various and Final Provisions**

### **Financial Matters**

**ARTICLE 13-** (1) Applications related to tuition fees, scholarships and other financial issues of students admitted from abroad are made by the Board of Trustees in accordance with the procedures and principles determined within the framework of the relevant legislation.

### **Repeal**

**ARTICLE 14-** (1) The “Directive on Admission of Students From Abroad To Associate Degree And Undergraduate Degree Programs” adopted at the University Senate's meeting dated 02/09/2020 has been repealed.

### **Cases Not Covered by Provisions and Ambiguous Situations**

**ARTICLE 15-** (1) In cases where there is no provision in this directive, the relevant decisions and regulations of the Council of Higher Education and the decisions taken by the Senate shall be acted upon.

(2) The Rector, the relevant Vice Rector, the Secretary General, the Secretary General, the relevant Deputy Secretary General, the Director of International Relations and unit managers are authorized to resolve any hesitant situations that may arise during the implementation of the provisions of the Directive.

### **Entry into Force**

**ARTICLE 16-** (1) This directive enters into force with the decision of the Senate

### **Execution**

**ARTICLE 17-** (1) The rector executes the provisions of this directive.
