Ethical Publication Policy

All authors submitting articles for review and publication agree to adhere to the following ethical conduct guidelines:

• Articles that have been previously published, accepted for publication, or are under review in any format (article, book, book chapter, printed proceedings, etc.) are not accepted for evaluation.

• Articles with multiple authors are not accepted unless approved by all authors.

• For studies requiring 'Ethics Committee Approval', the approval document must be submitted at the time of application.

Submitted articles must have a similarity (plagiarism) rate of less than 20%. (Similarity reports can be obtained from platforms such as turnitin.com, intihal.net, ithenticate.com, etc.)
If corrections are requested from the author, they must be made and submitted to the journal's editorial board within 1 month.

• An author cannot have more than one article published in the same issue. • The responsibility for the published articles rests entirely with the author(s).

• Authors must obtain permission from the owner(s) of the publication or copyright for all materials used in the article that do not belong to them. Authors are responsible for obtaining the necessary permissions.

• The Editorial Board may make changes to the content and format of the manuscript with the author's/authors' consent.

• Accepted and published articles cannot be republished without the publisher's permission.

• Articles are published as open access, and no fees are charged to authors at any stage, including submission, evaluation, acceptance, and publication.
