EVALUATION CRITERIA

- Below is the table on how the student will be selected. The top 2 students with the highest scores will be nominated to Felician University as an exchange student.

Criteria	Weighted Score
Cumulative Grade Point Average	50% (out of a total of 100 points)
Interview Score	50% (out of a total of 100 points)
Students who have previously participated in a Global Exchange or Erasmus+ exchange program	-5 points

INTERVIEW PROCESS

- The Global Exchange Programs Committee will conduct interviews as part of their jury duties to evaluate candidates. At the end of the interview, each student will receive a score out of 100 points. Students who score 69 points or below out of 100 will not be considered successful. During the interview, the committee will assess the candidate's language proficiency, ability to represent the university, reasons for participating in the exchange program, the academic and personal value the program will add to the student, the student's ability to reflect their experiences back to the university, and any national or international experiences if applicable.

ABOUT VISA AND FEES

- After being selected to go to Felician University, you will need to apply for a F1 Visa. You will not pay tuition to Felician University. However, you have to pay for the following:
 - Travel
 - Dormitories
 - Accessibility to reading/computer materials, library, and recreation center.
 - Cleaning of the facility, repairs, and other forms of maintenance of the campus.



- You will pay for health insurance upon arrival at Felician University. Make sure to get travel insurance before you go.

ABOUT ACCOMMODATION

- The exchange student must live on campus for the entire time they are studying at Felician. Only housing during the academic semester months is included in the housing fees. Any student who stays during the summer months or during winter break will be charged additional fees. Students may choose to live off campus during those times.
- The student will be assigned a double occupancy room. Single rooms may be available, upon request. However, these spaces are limited and are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis.

ABOUT LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

- If your program is in English, you will not need an English Requirement. However, if your program is in Turkish, you will need to present TOEFL score to Felician University in order to enter the exchange program.
- However, Felician University requires every student to take their English Proficiency Exam. The purpose of the exam is to see the student's English academic level. You will still continue your studies. They may ask you to take an additional 1 or 2 lessons of English depending on the result of the English Proficiency Exam.
