EVALUATION CRITERIA

• Below is the table on how the student will be selected. The top 6 students with the highest scores will be nominated to University of Western Cape as an exchange student.

Criteria	Weighted Score
Cumulative Grade Point Average	50% (out of a total of 100 points)
Interview Score	50% (out of a total of 100 points)
Students who have previously participated in a	5 mainta
Global Exchange or Erasmus+ exchange program	-5 points





INTERVIEW PROCESS

The Global Exchange Programs Committee will conduct interviews as part of their jury duties to evaluate candidates. At the end of the interview, each student will receive a score out of 100 points. Students who score 69 points or below out of 100 will not be considered successful. During the interview, the committee will assess the candidate's language proficiency, ability to represent the university, reasons for participating in the exchange program, the academic and personal value the program will add to the student, the student's ability to reflect their experiences back to the university, and any national or international experiences if applicable.
